PRAYER POINT ONE

Scripture

Let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever flowing stream. Amos 5:24

Prayer

PRAYER POINT TWO

Scripture

Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God. Matthew 5:9

Prayer

Father, heal divisions that persist between people, communities, and generations. Teach us to listen well, to repent where needed, and to love as You love. Empower us to be peacemakers who refuse hatred and choose the hard work of reconciliation. Let Your love disarm bitterness and restore trust.

PRAYER POINT THREE

A shared hope for future generations

Scripture

He has shown you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God. Micah 6:8

Prayer

God, we pray for the generations coming after us. May they inherit a vision shaped by justice, mercy, and humility. Guard them from cynicism and fear, and anchor them in hope. Give us the grace to model lives of faith and obedience so that the dream of a more just and unified society continues to move forward.
